Making sandwiches

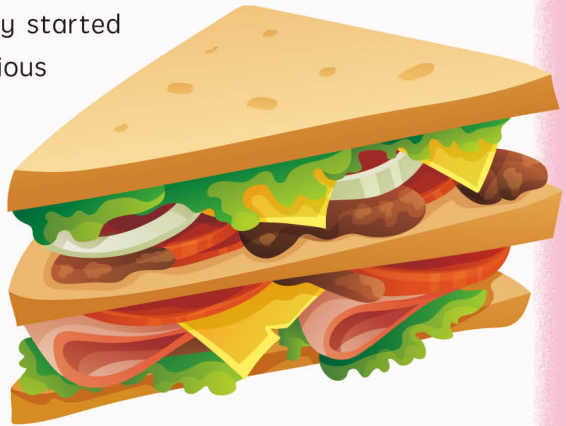
