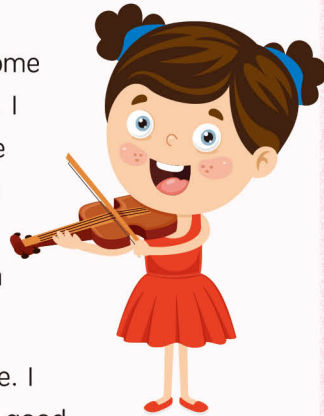
6A Ng Pui Lam, Gloria
