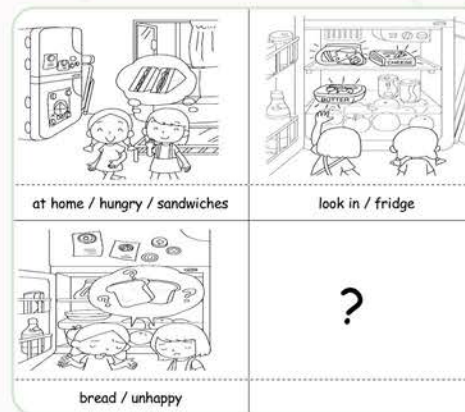


Teacher's comment
